Analyses are in accordance with Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater, 10th ed.

E.Coli values at the surface were very low. The highest observed value of bacteria is 110.0 CFU/100ml. Full body contact recreation (including swimming) counts of E. coli should not exceed 130 (CFU/100mL) as a monthly geometric mean of at least five samples per the State of Michigan standard, or single samples should not exceed 298 (CFU/100) (235 CFU/100mL in a designated bathing beach area) per Federal (EPA) guidelines.
