

Come back the next morning to pick up your stuffie, enjoy a light breakfast, and view a slideshow of all the fun your stuffies had during their sleepover.


Can't make it back in the morning? Come back anytime on Friday to pick up your stuffie and get a printout of the slideshow.

FEBRUARY 19 @ 4:30PM


Join our theme-based book club! Participants in 4th - 7th grade will eat pizza, discuss what they have read, and participate in a library auction to end the hour. Registration required.
